NAAC Sponsored Two Days National Seminar

Aravali College of Advanced Studies in Education organized a NAAC Sponsored Two Days National Seminar on Quality Assurance, Enhancement and Sustainability in Teacher Education on 7th and 8th February 2017. The response was overwhelming. The college received more than 150 abstracts, of which, about 40 percent were from outside the Haryana state and 60 percent from Haryana. In Inaugural Session welcome Address was delivered by Prof.(Dr.) Anshu Radha Aggarwal (Principal, Aravali College Of Advanced Studies in Education, Faridabad), Key Note Address was delivered by Prof. (Dr.) L.C. Singh (Formerly with NCERT) on Quality Teacher Education-Identification of Impact Factors. Prof. (Dr.) Illyas Hussain (Dean, Faculty of Education, Director Schools, JMI), Chief Guest inaugurated the seminar along with Guest of Honor Prof. (Dr.) S.K.Sinha (Former Registrar, CRSU, Jind) and Prof. (Dr.) Ismat Jahan Siddiqui, (HOD, IASE, JMI). This was followed by giving closing remarks given by Mr .Dhan Singh Bhadana(Chairman, Aravali College of Advanced Studies in Education).The Inaugural Session was followed by Technical Sessions.It had parallel sessions on each
