Research Committee

NAAC Sponsored Two Days National Seminar

Aravali College of Advanced Studies in Education organized a NAAC Sponsored Two Days National Seminar on Quality Assurance, Enhancement and Sustainability in Teacher Education on 7th and 8th February 2017. The response was overwhelming. The college received more than 150 abstracts, of which, about 40 percent were from outside the Haryana state and 60 percent from Haryana. In Inaugural Session welcome Address was delivered by Prof.(Dr.) Anshu Radha Aggarwal (Principal, Aravali College Of Advanced Studies in Education, Faridabad), Key Note Address was delivered by Prof. (Dr.) L.C. Singh (Formerly with NCERT) on Quality Teacher Education-Identification of Impact Factors. Prof. (Dr.) Illyas Hussain (Dean, Faculty of Education, Director Schools, JMI), Chief Guest inaugurated the seminar along with Guest of Honor Prof. (Dr.) S.K.Sinha (Former Registrar, CRSU, Jind) and Prof. (Dr.) Ismat Jahan Siddiqui, (HOD, IASE, JMI). This was followed by giving closing remarks given by Mr .Dhan Singh Bhadana (Chairman, Aravali College of Advanced Studies in Education). The Inaugural Session was followed by Technical Sessions. It had parallel sessions on each day for

presentation of papers by the delegates. The technical sessions were chaired by eminent educationists namely Prof. (Dr.) L.C. Singh, Formerly with NCERT, Prof. (Dr.) Ismat Jahan Siddiqui, HOD, IASE, JMI, Prof. (Dr.) B.P. Bhardwaj, Head, Dept. of Teacher Education, NCERT, Prof. (Dr.) Madhu Gupta, Former Head, Dept. of Education, MDU, Rohtak, Prof. (Dr.) Jitendra Kumar, Head, Dept. of Education, MDU, Rohtak and Prof. (Dr.) Ilyas Hussain, Dean, Faculty of Education, Director Schools, JMI, Dr. Sarita Bhardwaj, Principal, Bhartiya College of Education, Panhera, Prof. (Dr.) Jaimala Yadav, Principal Shiv College of Education, Tigaon. An Invited talk on “Corporate Governance and Quality Assurance in Teacher Education” was delivered by Prof. Shubhra Mangal, Principal of Chet Ram Sharma College of Education, Noida. In the Valedictory Session Prof. (Dr.) B.P. Bhardwaj, Head, Dept. of Teacher Education, NCERT was the Chief Guest, Prof. (Dr.) Madhu Gupta, Former Head, Dept. of Education, MDU, Rohtak and Prof. (Dr.) Jitendra Kumar, Head, Dept. of Education, MDU, Rohtak were guest of honor. The crisp overview of the seminar was presented by Organizing Secretary, Ms Bindiya Lakhani, followed by presentation of mementoes, distribution of certificates. The vote of thanks was given by the coordinator of the seminar, Dr. Vandana Sharma. The delegates from different states were highly satisfied with the enriched inputs received from a galaxy of eminent educationist from Jamia Milia Islamia, NCERT New Dehli, CRSU Jind and M.D. University Rohtak.
